5. (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—
- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
    - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
    - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be c7-BDC BTing o

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.”

## **Annex 2 Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

### **Conditions agreed with Sussex Police and 5 Guys JV Limited**

1. A CCTV system with recording equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained at the premises (unforeseen faults excepted). Images will be retained for a minimum of 28 days and supplied to a police officer upon reasonable request subject to the Data Protection Act 1998.

12. The staff of the premises shall carry out litter checks and shall remove litter within the external area as operated by Five Guys JV Limited or in the immediate vicinity.
13. All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be in sealed containers. save for in any external area as defined by the layout plan and forming part of the licensed area, and subject to the operating conditions included on the premises licence.
14. The need for Security Industry Authority (SIA) door staff will be risk assessed by the Designated Premises Supervisor in conjunction with the Premises Licence Holder and employed when deemed necessary.
