(These are: the prevention of crime and disorder; public safety; the prevention of public nuisance; and the protection of children from harm.)

It cannot be used to:

extend the period for which the licence has effect; vary substantially the premises to which it relates;

specify, in a premises licence, an individual as the designated premises supervisor; add the sale by retail or supply of alcohol as an activity authorised by a licence or certificate; authorise the sale by retail or supply of alcohol at any time between 11pm and 7am; authorise an increase in the amount of time on any day during which alcohol may be sold by retail or supplied;

include the alternative licence condition referred to in section 41D(3) of the Licensing Act 2003 in a premises licence.

- 2. <u>Description of premises</u>: For example the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives.
