- 6. The responsible person must ensure that ±
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures ±
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
 - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

Minimum Drinks Pricing

- 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
 - 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 ±
 - (a) $P = D + (D \times V)$
 - (b) $P = D + (D \times V)$
- Where ±
- (i) P is the permitted price
 - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were

3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from the paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of SDUDJUDSK RQ D GD\ ³WKH ILUVW GD\´ ZRXOG EH GLIIHUHG ³WKH VHFRQG GD\´ DV eDo the rate of duty is valid for the day.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Annex 2 ±Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- (1) Embedded restrictions under the Licensing Act 1964, the Cinematograph (Safety) Regulations 1955 and the Children & Young Persons Act 1933 are removed from this licence.
- (2) Any person known to be subject of an exclusion order made by the courts will be excluded from the premises.
- (3) CCTV to be

the PASS hologram or a valid photographic driving licence or a passport.

- (5) Any person under the age of 18 years will not be permitted to remain in the bar area after 21:00hrs, with the exception of those entering and leaving the restaurant within the premises.
- (6) All incidents of crime and disorder will be reported to police, in cases of emergency by 999 and in all other cases by telephone or email to the police licensing office and recorded in an incident log book
